



## *Martin Millar, Mayor*

*Martin (Marty) Millar was elected to the South Palm Beach City Council in 2005 and re-elected for Mayor on March 10, 2009. After a long career in both the Police and Fire Departments he is now retired, with honors, from both services.*

*He began his career in law enforcement in 1970, as a Police Academy graduate from the Jersey City Police Academy in Hudson County, New Jersey. He served as a Patrol Officer and retired from the North Bergen Police Department as Detective.*

*His career in the Fire Department spans from 1975 to 1996, where he served as a Firefighter and acting Captain with the North Bergen Fire Department.*

*Mayor Millar moved to South Palm Beach in 2000, and became active in local public service affairs by first serving on the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee of South Palm Beach as Parade Coordinator and was subsequently elected to the Town Council. As a member of the Florida League of Cities, he serves on the Florida Municipal Legislative Council, a body that addresses the issues of affordable housing throughout the State of Florida. In 2007, Mayor Millar became a Member of the Palm Beach County Criminal Justice Commission. He is very proud of his affiliation with this outstanding organization.*

She retired from Columbia H.S., in Maplewood New Jersey, as a Special Education Teacher and currently volunteers with United Way and the Palm Beach County Public School System.*
